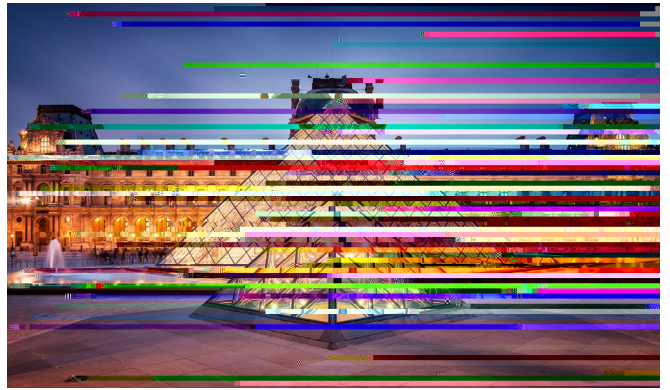

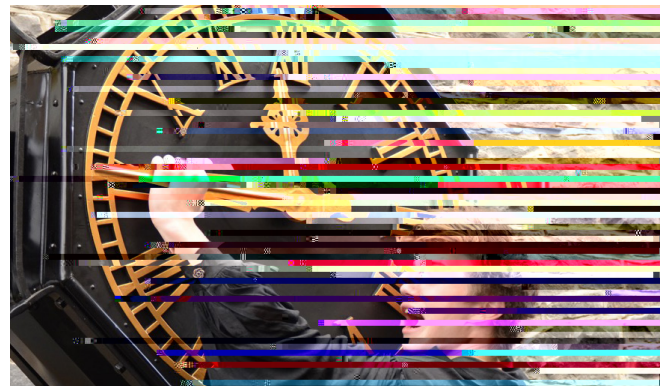


Gridsystem
